Website Content Research & Development

Programs Support

- **Artist Opportunities Miner:** Research local & state opps and enter in database. Duration: Ongoing weekly; Web-based remote work.
- **ART ON F1RST Window Maintenance:** Handle interior and exterior installation space and window cleaning. Duration: Ongoing monthly.
- **Calendar Data Management:** NVarts.org events mining and submission and entry editing. Duration: Ongoing weekly; Web-based remote work.
- **Online Artist Registry:** Maintain the online Registry which involves graphics editing, uploading and application mgmt. Duration: Ongoing as needed; Web based remote work.
- **Exhibition Hanging:** Assistance with quarterly Student Art Exhibitions and yearly Meet the Makers exhibition display, hanging and wall lettering. Duration: as needed, on-site.

- **Videographer / Film Editor for Special Events:** Shoot ACNV special events and edit. Duration: as needed, on-site.
