**Arts in Education-** provides visual and performing arts education in many disciplines to Napa schoolchildren, and offers employment to professional, local, pre-screened artists

**Open Studios Tour-** an annual two-weekend event that connects the public with around 100 local artists, who welcome visitors into their private studios all over the valley

**ARTscan E-Newsletter-** a bi-monthly online publication that includes local artist profiles, poetry and prose, artist opportunities, event listings, as well as editorials that address issues facing our cultural community

**Professional Artist Workshop Series-** monthly lectures designed to give working artists the tools they need to become more profitable and more successful at making a living through their art

**Online Artist Registry-** a searchable database on the Arts Council website that contains detailed information on all participating member artists, including resumes, biographies, artist statements, web links, contact information, and up to ten images or writing samples for each artist. The website also includes comprehensive pages of Artist Opportunities and Resources, as well as a Community Arts Message Board.

**Revolving Door Art-** a program connected to our Artist Registry that allows Napa County businesses, wineries, and non-profits to search the Registry and book rotating shows of local art
