Intro to Drama

Grade Levels: K-5

Students explore the fundamentals of dramatic expression. Focus will be on stage presence, vocal projection, body movement, improvisation and pantomime.

Program: Classes are 1 hour. Course is 6 weeks, but can be extended indefinitely.

Play Production

Grade Levels: 3-5

Students participate in a full length school play. The production requires 15 one-hour rehearsals in a seven week block (generally two rehearsals a week for six weeks followed by the production week, which requires student participation for two rehearsals and three shows). A maximum of 20 students can participate in one production. Every child will participate (no one has to be a "tree"). Some rehearsals can be held after school if needed.
