A big crowd turned out on July 14 for a walking tour and reception to officially kick off the first annual Napa ARTwalk. Created by the Napa Community Redevelopment Agency and Arts Council Napa Valley, the ARTwalk has proven to be an unqualified success as locals and visitors enjoy ten works of sculpture that have been placed along First Street, Main Street and the Riverfront Promenade. Voting boxes created by artists at Vine Village can be found at Downtown locations and residents are invited to cast a ballot to determine a People's Choice Award to be presented at the end of the exhibition.

## Flood Project work on Napa Creek set to start soon

Construction is set to begin soon on the Napa Creek portion of the Flood Protection Project. The major impact of this work will occur during installation of two large culverts passing under Pearl Street and Main Street parallel to the creek. A closure of Main between Pearl and the creek will be necessary for a multi-week period. Work will also take place upstream as terraces are excavated, and an additional culvert will be built south of Behrens Street. The Behrens Street bridge will be removed as part of this work plan. ## NEWS from the Community Development Department

The City of Napa is now in the process of selecting an applicant for a Medical Marijuana Dispensary Use Permit. The application period opened August 9, 2010 and will end on October 18, 2010. All applications must be submitted using forms and instructions available from the City's Community Development Department and applications must be accompanied by an initial processing deposit of \$7,000.
